With periods in which elective surgeries were cancelled, including corneal transplant surgeries, SightLife is staring to see our eye bank volumes returning.

We are pleased to report that the activities of the Northwest Lions Foundation' health screening programs are growing as more schools are bringing students back into in person classes.

In addition, the NLF Board of Trustees approved over \$35,000 in project support grants, including a \$5,000 grant to help flood victims in the Northwest counties of District H.
